

Position paper

to the Call for Proposals SKHU/1901

In order the approved Territorial Action Plans for Employment submitted for the Call SKHU-1703 fulfil their original objectives also the conditions set in the first round of the selection procedure, incorporated projects elaborated for the second round but rejected after the eligibility assessment are provided with a possibility to be re-submitted.

According to the decision of the Monitoring Committee of the Interreg V-A Slovakia-Hungary Cooperation Programme, the Managing Authority in agreement with the National Authority opens restricted Call for proposals SKHU-1901 as the second round of the selection procedure in the third priority axis of the Cooperation Programme. The ERDF allocation for the present Call is 2 300 803,42 EUR. The Monitoring Committee reserves the right to award different amount of the available funds. The deadline for the submission of the applications is 8th July 2019.

The present Call is the continuation of the second round of the selection procedure in the third priority axis of the Co-operation Programme and restricted only for the projects that were rejected after the eligibility assessment of the Call for proposals SKHU-1802 as follows:
